## Make A Patriotic Mailbox

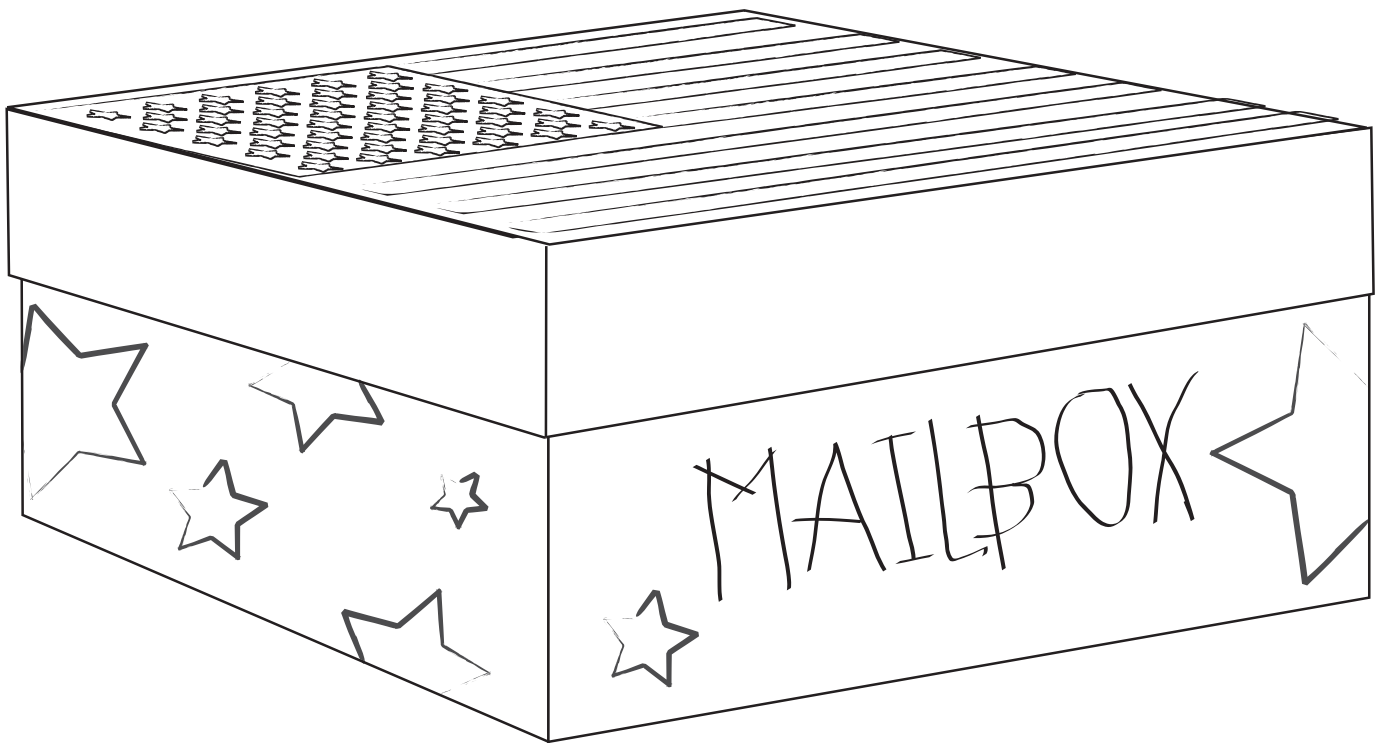
While Dad is deployed, you will probably send each other cards and letters. This patriotic mailbox will give you a special place to keep letters to and from Dad.

- ★ Empty shoebox
- ★ Red, white, and blue colored paper
- ★ Star Stickers
- ★ Glue stick

- ★ Tape

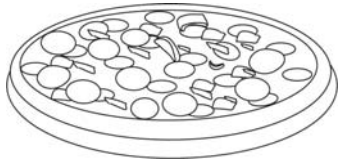
To make your own mailbox:

1. Cover the shoebox with white paper. Cover the lid and bottom separately.
2. Cut a 4-inch square of blue paper and add star stickers. Attach the square with the stars to the upper left corner of the box lid.
3. Cut 1 inch strips of red paper. Glue to the top for the flag stripes.
4. Write MAILBOX on the side of your box. Use your mailbox for letters to and from Dad.

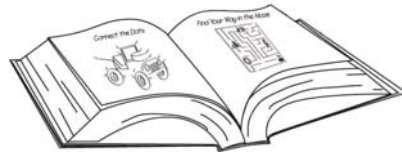
