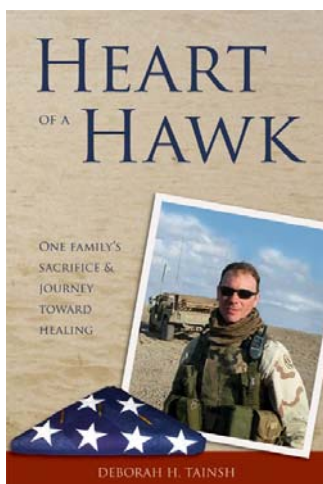

Engaging Speaker, Deborah Tainsh

Known for her good cheer and compassion, military wife and mom Deborah Tainsh speaks with military families and civilians, taking them to the front lines of the battle for freedom and into her own family's sacrifice and triumph over adversity. Deborah touches hearts and strikes a deep chord in every person in her audience. Her message: We must honor the heroism of our nation's armed forces and the families left behind.

Deborah's stepson, U.S. Army Sergeant Patrick Tainsh, was killed by a roadside bomb in Iraq on February 11, 2004. Deborah turned to writing to sort out her grief, capturing the raw and tender moments of her family's sorrow and remembrance. Her book *Heart of a Hawk: One family's sacrifice & journey toward healing* brings readers into the Tainsh family's living room as Deborah and her husband, retired USMC Sergeant Major David Tainsh, hear the tragic news of their son's death and begin their struggle toward acceptance and peace.

To grieving families, Deborah offers understanding hugs, tangible coping ideas, and inspirational stories from others who have faced the death of a loved one. For other groups, she shares her experiences, stories, and joys as a military wife and mom. Each presentation is unique and can be tailored to your group's needs.

Partnership with TAPS

A portion of the proceeds from *Heart of a Hawk* goes to the Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors, a nonprofit group for those grieving the loss of a loved one who died while serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. Deborah and David became TAPS mentors after their life-changing experience and talk with other survivors across the nation. They share their continuing journey while celebrating a son's courageous life with a message that "our children expect no less courage and giving from us than what they showed the world."
