Host provides workshop facility and covers any additional event costs, such as lunch or day care for the participants.

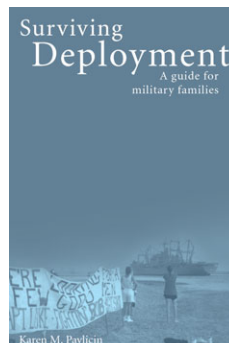
